



The ESCANABA RIVER is a river in the Upper Peninsula of Michigan.In his poem The Song of Hiawatha, Henry Wadsworth Longfellow describes how Hiawatha "crossed the rushing Escanaba". It is a wide river that cuts into limestone beds. The upper river is rocky and scenic and supports brook, brown and some rainbow trout throughout along with warm water species in the impoundments. The East Branch and the Middle Branch of the Escanaba converge in the town of Gwinn to form the Main Branch. The stretch from this convergence south to the Delta County line is mostly wide and smooth, ideal for a kayak/canoe trip. Dams on the river's branches require caution.

Soaring Eagle Outfitters offers several choices for the kayak or canoe enthusiast. This river system is full of great paddling stretches, Soaring Eagle Outfitters can assist with planning a great trip.

After your adventure, you many choose to head over to one of our local restaurants, or grill at newly renovated Peter Nordeen Park. For you camping people there are campgrounds nearby.

On your trip watch for Bald Eagles, as well as, whitetail deer, black bear, birds, and wildlife that are native to Michigan's Upper Peninsula. The scenic beauty and the flowing river system is reason enough to come here and paddle.






















2 1/2 Hours - Rock Quarry Trip - 6 Miles

A Soaring Eagle Outfitters staff member will transport you to the access location. In about 15-20 minutes you will enter Third Falls; you can choose to go thru or portage. In about 40-50 minutes you will then enter the Second Falls. This will give you a little challenge; once more, you can choose to go thru or portage. Your trip will conclude in about 10-15 after you pass the Forsyth Township Camp Ground where a Soaring Eagle Outfitters staff member will meet you at the Forsyth Township Canoe Launch Site.

Forsyth Township Canoe Launch

2 ½ Hours - High Power Line Trip - 4.5 Miles

A Soaring Eagle Outfitters staff member will put you in at the Forsyth Township Canoe Launch site where you will begin your trip down the Escanaba River. In about 10-15 minutes, the Middle Branch and East Branch River's meet. In another 40-50 minutes you will go under a swinging chair, this is almost the half-way point of your trip. In another 50-60 minutes you will see on your left side *High Power Lines*, when you get to the opening/field on the left, this is where you will exit the river. Please use caution. A member of the Soaring Eagles Outfitter's staff will meet you at the landing and bring you back to our headquarters.

3 Hours - Iron Pin Trip - 6 Miles

A Soaring Eagle Outfitters staff member will put you in at the Forsyth Township Canoe Launch site where you will begin your trip down the Escanaba River. In about 10-15 minutes, the Middle Branch and East Branch River's meet. In another 40-50 minutes you will go under a swinging chair, this is approximately one-third of your trip. In another 40-50 minutes, you will see on your left side, high power lines, (this is also known as the swinging bridge location). After that point you have 40-50 minutes left of your trip. You will see some more power lines, which cross the river, right after that, on the left side, is the Iron Pin boat landing, which is where you will exit the River. Please take-out on the right side of the concrete ramp. A member of the Soaring Eagles Outfitter's staff will meet you at the Iron Pin boat-landing and bring you back to our headquarters.


3 Hours – Iron Pin Trip – 6 Miles Continued for page #1

6 Hours – Little West Trip – Approximately 12 Miles

A Soaring Eagle Outfitters staff member will put you in at the Forsyth Township Canoe Launch site where you will begin your trip down the Escanaba River. In about 10-15 minutes, the Middle Branch and East Branch River's meet. In 40-50 minutes you will go under a swinging chair. In another 40-50 minutes, you will see on your left side, high power lines. More power lines will cross the river in approx. 50-60 minutes. On the left side after the Power Lines you will see the Iron Pin boat landing. You are at the half-way point of your trip. After another 1 ½ hours, you will see on your right, the where the Big West Creek enters the Escanaba River. You have about 50-60 minutes left on your trip. Watch for the Little West Road on your Right, this is where you will you exit the River, where a member of the Soaring Eagle Outfitters staff will met you and bring you back to our headquarters.

8-10 Hours – Boney Falls Trip – 30 Miles

A Soaring Eagle Outfitters staff member will transport you to the access site. The Escanaba River from Gwinn south to Boney Falls offers a Northwood's paddling adventure that can be a day tip or overnight experience. The river flows on the Precambrian shield, with rugged outcroppings of rock, sheer cliffs, towering hardwood forests, and pine plains. It can be a moderately swift flowing river especially early in the spring run-off and slows down as the summer progresses. This is a great trip to get close to nature and experience the outdoors. Wildlife such as whitetail deer, eagles, sandhill cranes, beaver, foxes, ducks, and black bear abound is this area. Excellent fishing opportunities. Being of the best Michigan rivers for trout the Escanaba and its tributaries offer a varied and challenging experience.
